

Decision No. 2024/025 of the Executive Director relating to public holidays for 2025

The Executive Director of the European Maritime Safety Agency (EMSA), having regard to the Staff Regulations of Officials and the Conditions of Employment of Other Servants of the European Communities and in particular to Article 61 thereto.

Having regard to the Commission Decision C (2024) 1719 final;

Having regard to the decision of the Director from the EMCDDA regarding public holidays for 2025,

Having consulted the Staff Committee;

Whereas it is relevant to consider the public holidays in Portugal,

Has decided:

Article 1

The following days will be considered public holidays in 2025:

1 January	Wednesday, New Year's Day
2 January	Thursday, day following New Year
17 April	Maundy Thursday
18 April	Good Friday
21 April	Easter Monday
25 April	Friday, Portuguese Freedom Day
1 May	Thursday, Labour Day
9 May	Friday, Anniversary of the Schuman Declaration
10 June	Tuesday, Portugal Day
13 June	Friday, Saint Anthony Day
15 August	Friday, Assumption Day
1 December	Monday, Portuguese Restoration of Independence Day
23 to 31 December	End of year (7 days)

TOTAL: 19 Days

Article 2

Work will resume as normal on Friday, 3 January 2025. Without prejudice to the schedule of public holidays for 2025, Thursday 2 January 2025 will be a public holiday.

Article 3

The Executive Director reserves the right to establish a minimum service during the public holidays, should the needs of the service so require.

Article 4

Subject to the Commission Decision on holiday flexibility arrangements due to be published beginning of 2025, the expected dates under the holiday flexibility arrangements of the implementing provisions on leave and absences applied to the Agency by analogy are expected to be:

17 April 2025	Maundy Thursday
18 April 2025	Good Friday
