


Invitation to tender

Procurement procedure N° EMSA/NEG/46/2015 for a water and foam fire extinguishing system

Subject & requirements	<p>The European Maritime Safety Agency (EMSA) is launching an invitation to tender for a water and foam fire extinguishing system for two diesel tanks placed in the basement and the 2nd floor roof of the EMSA building.</p> <p>The tanks have the capacity of</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 1,600m³ (in the basement) - 2,500m³ (in the 2nd floor roof) <p>Tenderers are requested to offer a solution for each of the locations. Please see Annex I for the related 2nd floor roof and Basement plans.</p> <p>1. Tenderers are requested to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - assess the capacity needs for extinguishing agent, according to the capacity of the tanks and the type of the proposed agent. - define the full project for the areas to intervene, bearing in mind all necessary technical requirements and existing tank capacity. - provide a statement of responsibility for the calculations and installation project. <p>The required system shall include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) Automatic fire detection system, which must be connected and communicate with the building's central fire detection system b) Automatic triggering mechanism, with the option of manual start c) Storage containers for the extinguishing and propellant agents d) Pipeline network for the extinguishing agent e) Discharge nozzles <p>2. Following the installation of the system, the contractor shall deliver the final plans of the system, a maintenance plan and an implementation plan, which shall include operational instructions, safety procedures, full detailed technical information about the system.</p> <p>3. The contractor shall provide training on the system to a maximum of 10 persons designated by EMSA and 2 years maintenance.</p> <p>All works shall include: the protection of the areas to intervene, works as described above, cleaning of the area of intervention and removal of surplus materials.</p> <p>The contractor shall be responsible for any damage caused to the building.</p> <p>The price offer must be all inclusive (include the costs of the all works, materials and transport, maintenance and training).</p>
