

**DECISION OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD OF 24 JANUARY 2014  
Adopting Implementing Rules to the revised Staff Regulations**

THE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD OF THE EUROPEAN MARITIME SAFETY AGENCY,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EC) No 1406/2002 of 27 June 2002 establishing a European Maritime Safety Agency, as amended, and in particular Article 6;

Having regard to the Staff Regulations of Officials and Conditions of Employment of Other Servants of the European Union, laid down by Council Regulation (EEC, EURATOM, ECSC) No 259/68, as amended, and in particular to Article 110 of the Staff Regulations;

Having regard to the decisions of the Commission setting up implementing rules for the application of the revised Staff Regulations of Officials of the European Union and the Conditions of Employment of other servants of the European Union which shall apply by analogy to the agencies and enter into force nine months after their entry into force at the Commission, pursuant to Article 110(2) of the Staff Regulations;

Whereas an Agency may decide that such implementing rules enter into force at an earlier date after consultation of the Staff Committee;

Whereas EMSA in cooperation with the Permanent Working Group of Regulatory Agencies has identified a series of implementing rules that need to be adopted immediately upon introduction of the revised Staff Regulations;

After consultation of the Staff Committee.

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

**Article 1**

The general implementing rules of the Staff Regulations, as adopted by the Commission and as listed in Annex, shall apply by analogy to the staff of EMSA.


**Article 2**
