DECISION OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD EXTENDING THE EMSA 5-YEAR STRATEGY 2020 – 2024

THE ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD OF THE EUROPEAN MARITIME SAFETY AGENCY,

Having regard to the European Parliament and Council Regulation 1406/2002, of 27 June 2002, as amended, establishing a European Maritime Safety Agency (hereafter EMSA or the Agency) and in particular Articles 10.2 (ca) and 15.2(a) thereof;

Having regard to the Decision of the EMSA Administrative Board of 8 November 2019 adopting the EMSA 5 year Strategy 2020-2024;

Having regard to the Commission's legislative proposal concerning the revision of the Agency's mandate which anticipates that there will be no need for a separate 5-year Strategy, and long-term planning will be covered by the multiannual part of the Single Programming Document;

Having regard to the legislative process concerning the Commission's legislative proposal for the revision of the Agency's mandate, which is well advanced and is expected to be completed shortly and likely to render unnecessary the preparation of a new strategy;


Having regard to the fact that the current EMSA 5-year Strategy 2020-2024 represents a suitable strategic framework for the interim;
